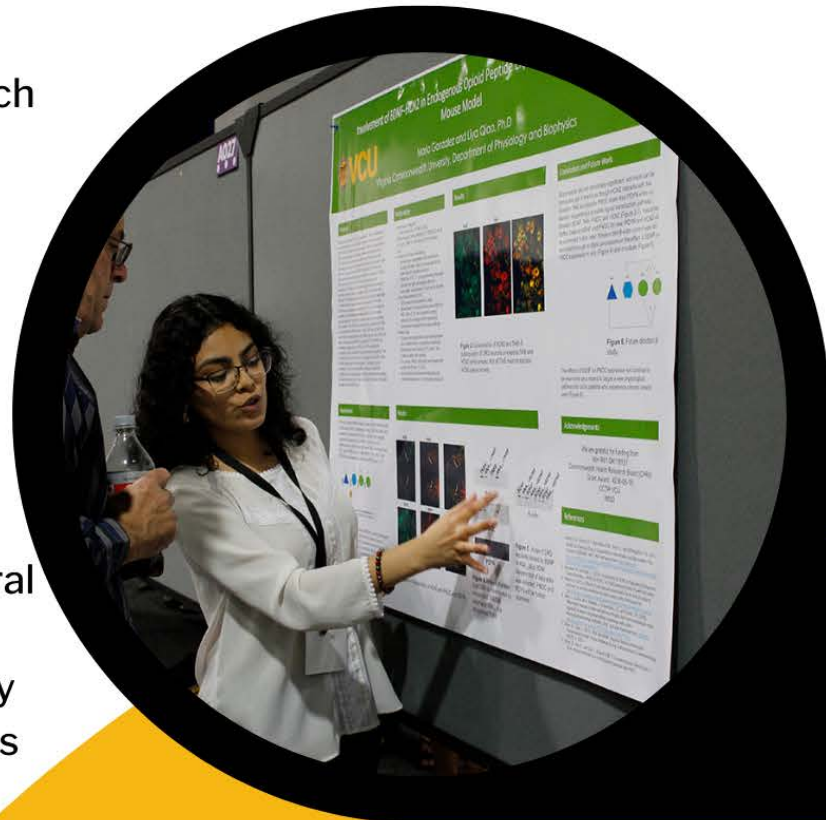
MAXIMIZING ACCESS TO RESEARCH CAREERS

The MARC program is designed to prepare students to apply for graduate programs in the Biomedical or Behavioral Sciences. MARC scholars must have 2 years remaining of undergraduate study and will be involved in program activities until graduation.
